Initiated and organized by the Anna Polke Foundation within the context of the exhibition of the same name at Kunsthalle Düsseldorf in collaboration with Düsseldorf Art Academy

In an age of fake news based on image manipulation (even at HD resolution), virtual reality, and an infinite visual cosmos of JPEGs and GIFs, it has long been clear that we cannot trust our eyes. Imagery, whether manually or technologically produced, does not depict reality as much as play a decisive role in forging it, which may include transmission errors, loss of quality, hacks, and other disruptions. While Sigmar Polke was studying at Düsseldorf Art Academy during the early 1960s, his interest soon turned to the imagery of the time that was being widely disseminated through the mass media. The transmitting and disrupting, the transforming and recoding of these images, including the visual glitches that resulted or were exposed, became a motif and early trademark in his Rasterbilder, paintings based on the halftone printing technique, and remained a central tool in his work thereafter. In view of current technological developments it is not surprising that it is just as productive for artists today to appropriate the ever-expanding continuum of imagery and trends to create something new.
